Official Propane Rules, Regulations & Pricing Policy

Official Propane Vendor

The San Gennaro Feast has designated an official propane vendor for all propane-related services during the feast. No outside propane tanks or propane vendors are permitted.

1. Vendor Requirements & Safety Regulations

1. Vendors are prohibited from bringing any outside propane tanks onto feast grounds, including empty tanks. Any outside tanks will be confiscated.
2. Only propane tanks supplied by the Official San Gennaro Feast Propane Vendor are permitted on-site.
3. Vendors are permitted a maximum of two propane tanks per appliance.
4. Active propane tanks must remain a minimum of five (5) feet apart from one another.
5. All propane tanks must remain visible and accessible for FDNY inspection at all times. Tanks may not be hidden, covered, enclosed, or obstructed.
6. Each propane tank must be connected directly to a single appliance. Splitters, diverters, or multi-appliance connections are strictly prohibited.
7. Vendors must have a qualified individual with a valid FDNY G-23 Certificate of Fitness present during all propane tank disconnections and reconnections.
8. **All vendors must register an account with the Official Propane Vendor no later than August 31.**
9. At the conclusion of each night, all propane tanks must be disconnected, lined up behind the vendor stand, and secured together using the provided chain and lock system.

2. Official Propane Vendor Services

1. The Official Propane Vendor will supply propane tanks to all vendors approved by the San Gennaro Feast committee.
2. The Official Propane Vendor will be on-site beginning the Monday prior to the start of the feast to begin propane distribution and account setup.
3. Each vendor will receive a chain and uniquely assigned lock for nightly propane tank security.
4. **All official propane tanks will be marked and tagged for identification and tracking purposes.**
5. Standard propane exchanges and deliveries will take place before 8:00 AM daily.
6. The Official Propane Vendor will remain available on-site for emergency purposes for one (1) hour after official feast closing each night.
7. On the final night of the feast, vendors must secure all propane tanks behind their former stand location for pickup and collection.
8. The Official Propane Vendor will collect all propane tanks from feast grounds by 8:00 AM following the conclusion of the feast.

3. Pricing & Deposits

1. A refundable tank deposit will be collected prior to the feast.
2. Tank deposits will be returned once all assigned tanks are returned and verified by the Official Propane Vendor.
3. Standard propane refills/exchanges are \$50 per tank with empty tank exchange.
4. Emergency propane exchanges during active feast hours are \$55 per tank exchange with empty tank exchange.

4. Violations, Fines & Liability

1. Failure to comply with these rules and regulations may result in violations and fines issued by the FDNY.
2. Vendors are solely responsible for all fines, violations, damages, or penalties associated with:
 - Their stand
 - Their propane usage
 - Their assigned propane tanks
 - Improper propane handling or storage
3. The San Gennaro Feast and the Official Propane Vendor reserve the right to suspend propane service to any vendor found in violation of these regulations, including but not limited to tampering with propane tank tags, tracking devices, or other safety and identification measures.
